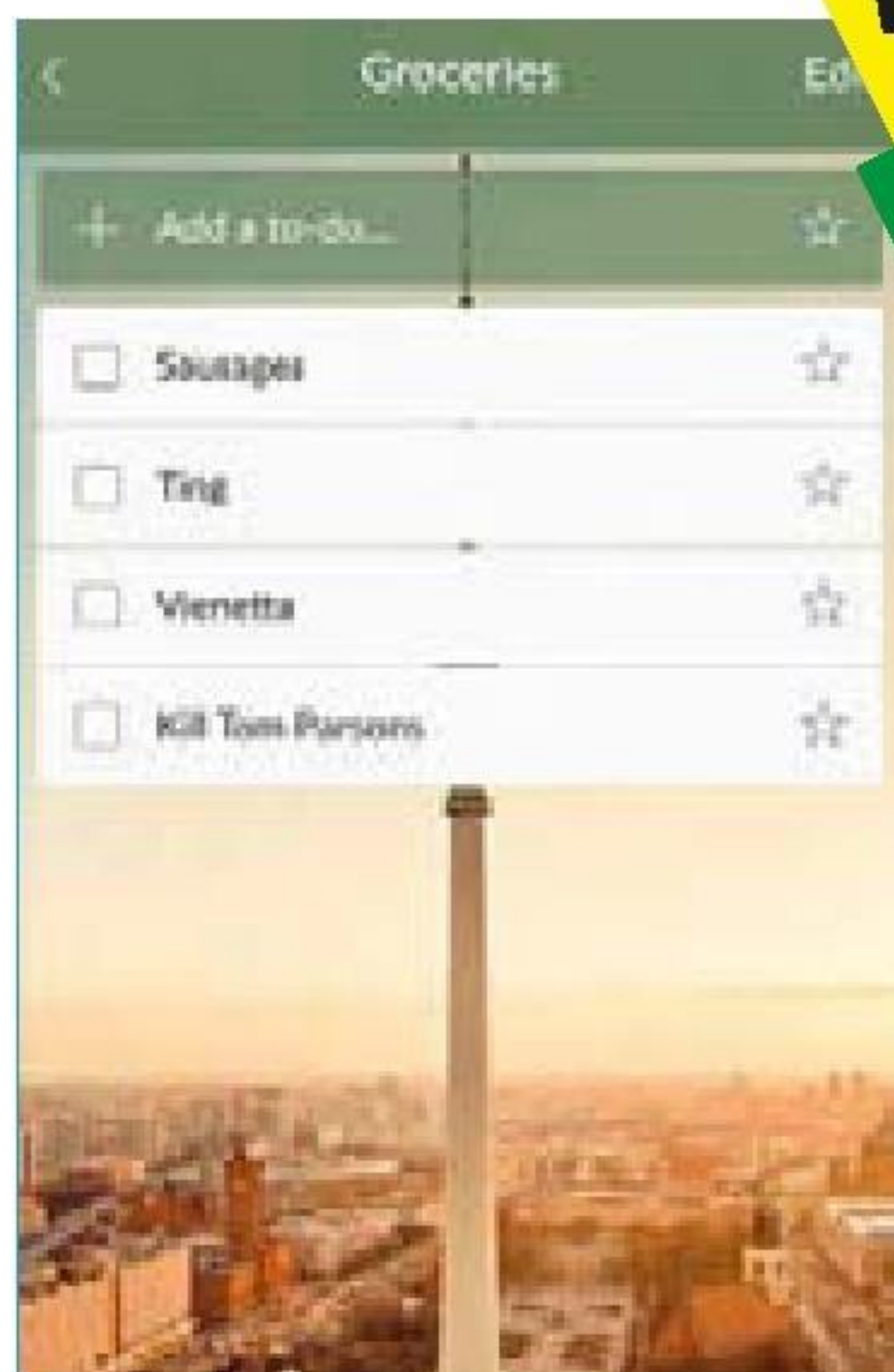
● CTRL-F

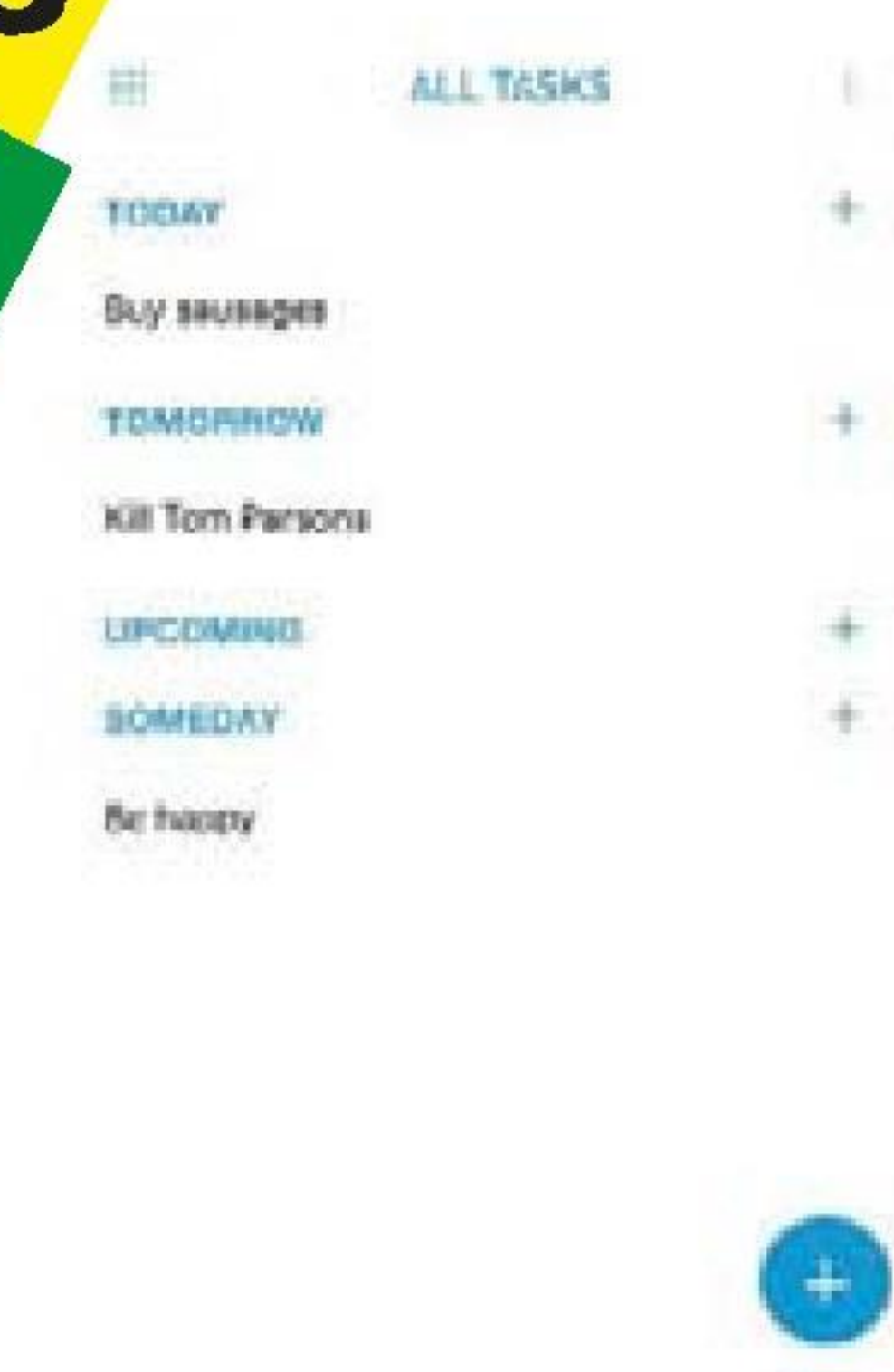

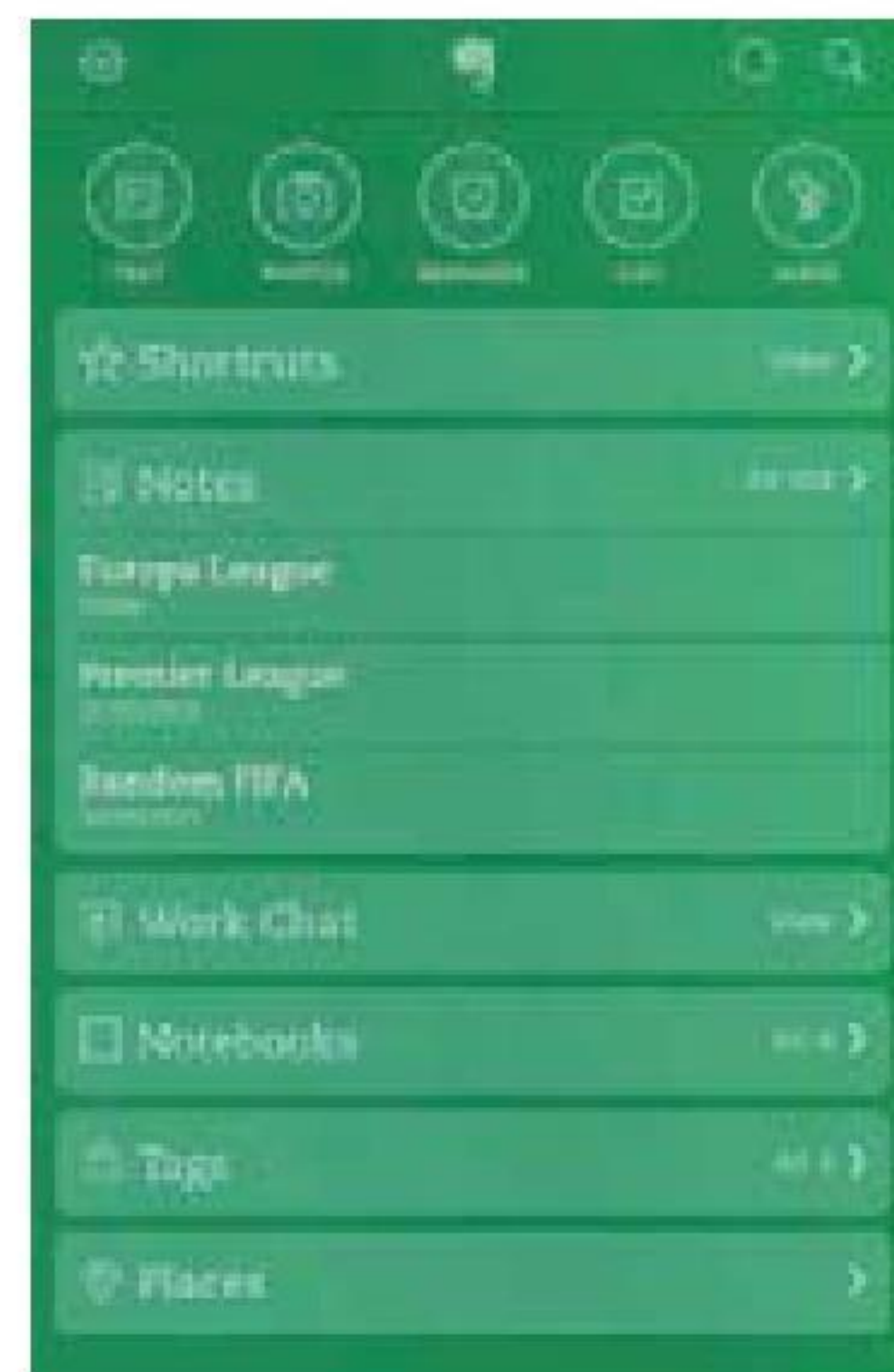

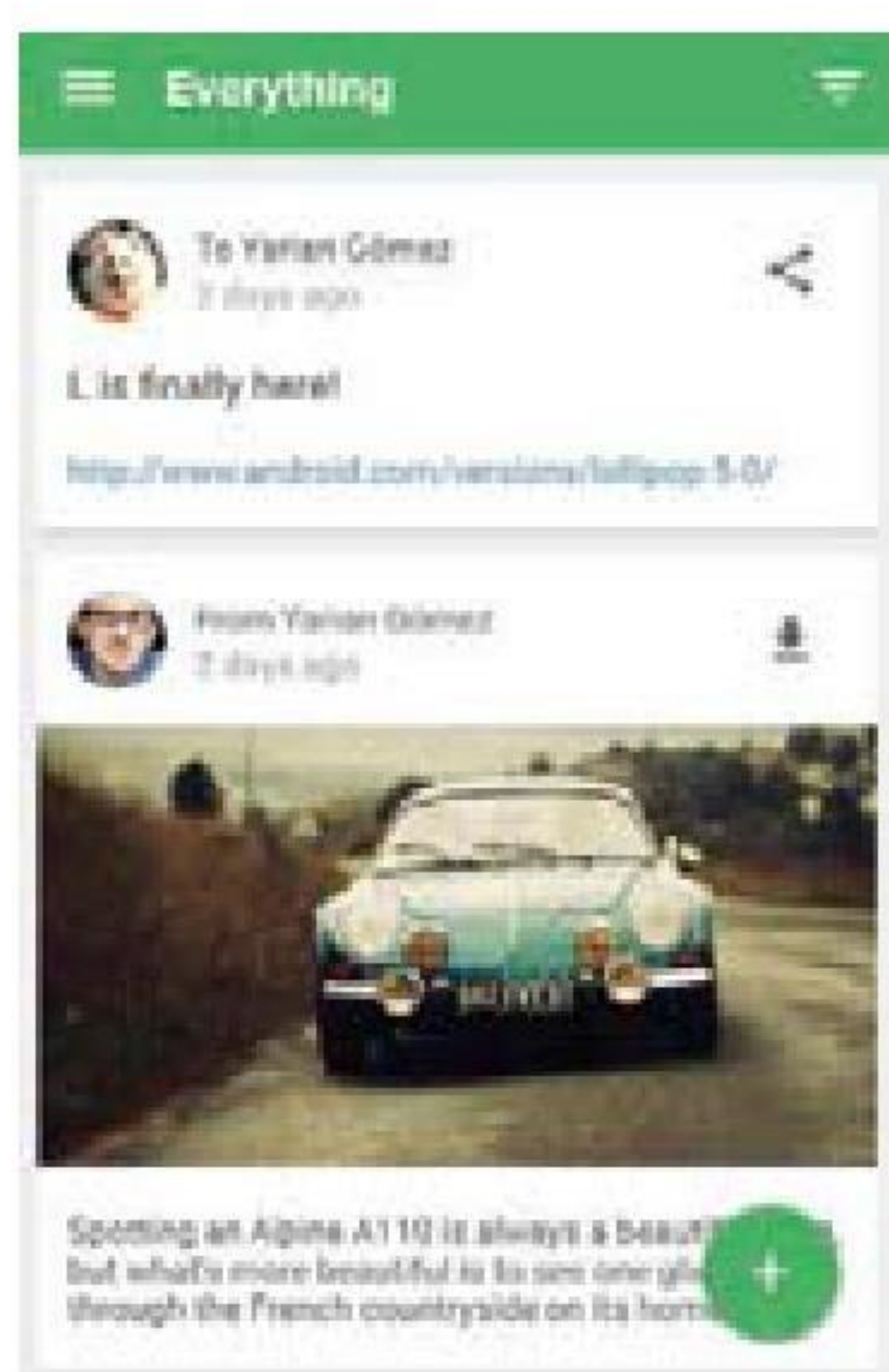


● EVERNOTE

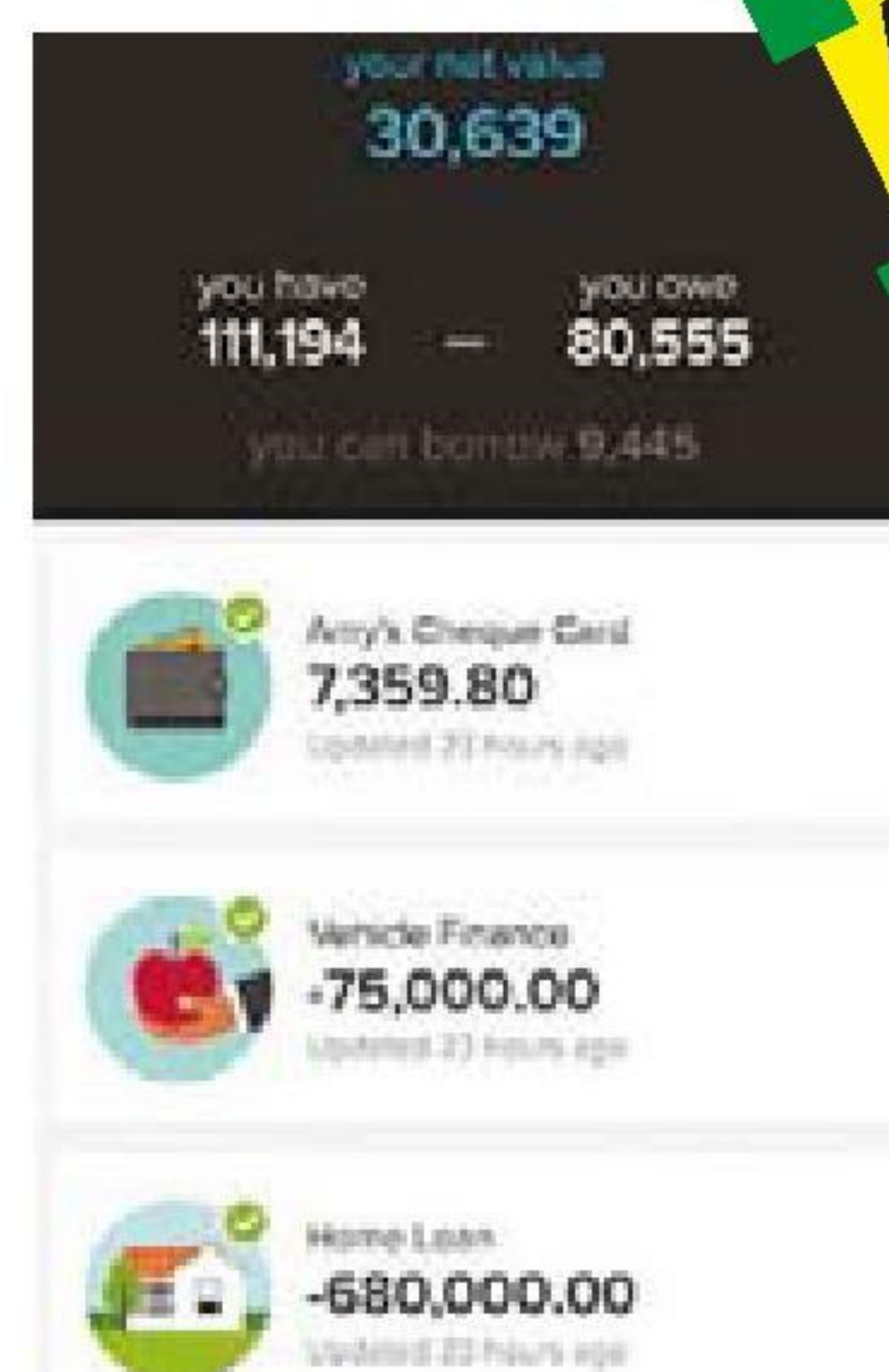

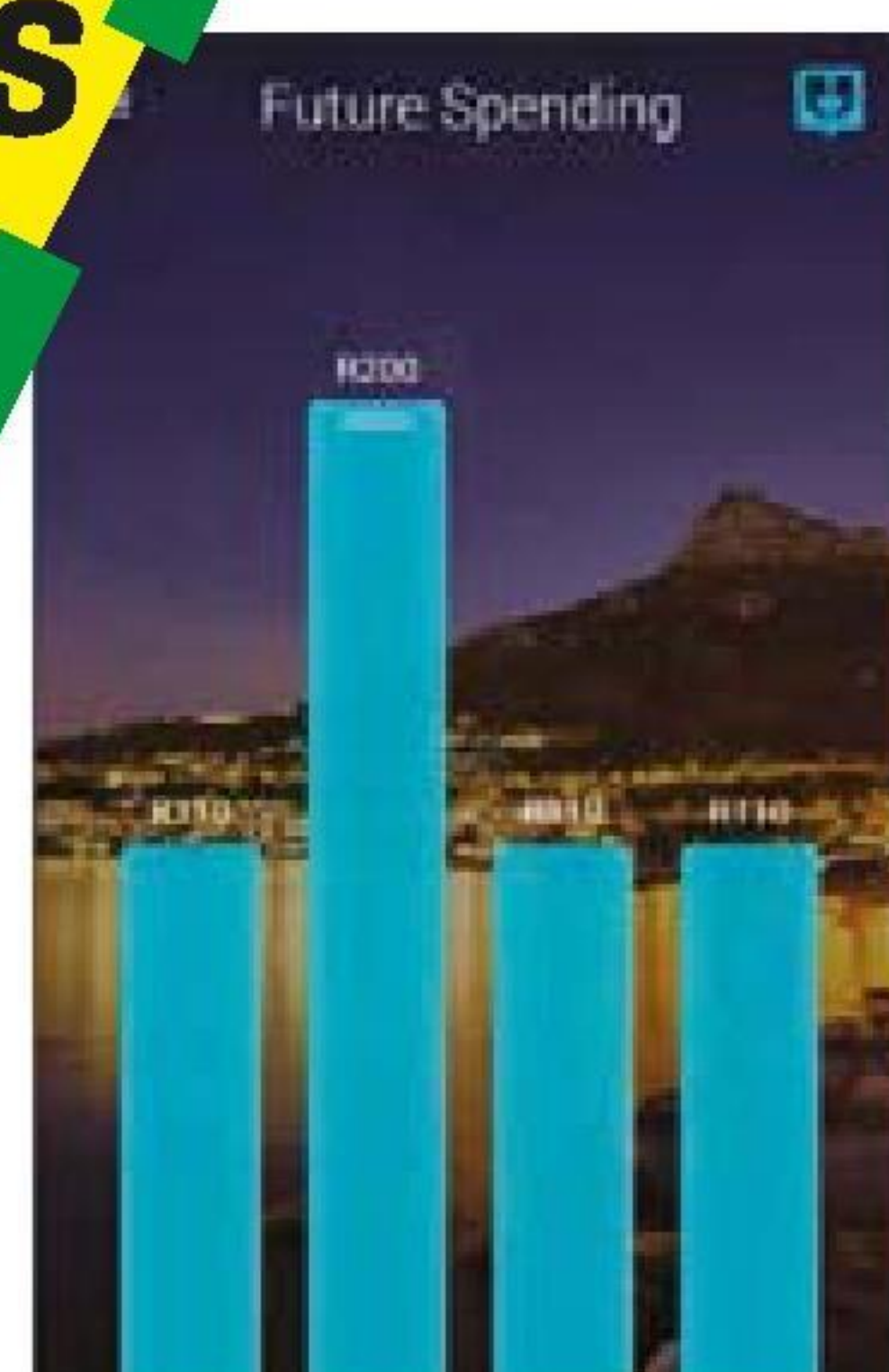
